1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 IEC Partnership

1.2 Registration Application

All users may access the Registration Application to view IEC course availability and track training records for their respective bookings. IEC Partners have global access to all training records. Others may access training records for their respective bookings. Access to information is controlled per the IEC Privacy Policy.

1.3 Payment Policy

All organizations that book training are responsible for making payment to the IEC. Purchases made by the *IEC Partnership* may be invoiced or paid by credit card. There are no penalties for cancellations or re-bookings made by IEC Partners; however, booked "no-shows" and outstanding payments are tracked and reported to the IEC Board of Directors.

Purchases made by *non-IEC Partners* must be pre-paid using a credit card or other acceptable means. IEC course cancellations are fully refunded or rebooked if made 48 hours prior to the course date. Audit cancellations are fully refunded or rebooked if made 5 business days prior to the audit.

New Worker Web-Based BSO Prerequisite (valid – see below)	BSO-NWPT . This online course is a pre-requisite for new workers seeking to complete the regional Basic Safety Orientation. It includes a basic introduction to key legal requirements, safe work planning, hazard recognition and control at member sites across Sarnia-Lambton.	\$10.00	4 hrs
Basic Safety Orientation (valid – 3 yrs)	 BSO-BSOP. This classroom-based course provides a review of safe work planning processes with a focus on hazards that are posing relatively high risk to workers across our region. This course is valid for three years and is required for entry into member sites. Prerequisites: Proof of current WHMIS and BSO-NWPT completed within previous 90 days or Valid BSO or valid BSR (within 30 day grace) 	\$100.00	4 hrs
Confined Space Attendant & Entrant (valid – 3 yrs)	GEN-CSATT . This awareness training program is intended to provide participants with the knowledge necessary to function as an entrant or attendant (hole watch) and to work safely in and around confined spaces. Participants will learn about regulatory requirements of Ontario Regulation 632/05.	\$100.00	3 hrs
General Safety Watch/ Attendant (valid – 3 yrs)	 GEN-SWATT. This awareness training provides the knowledge necessary to be a Safety Watch/Attendant for mobile equipment (i.e., spotter), supplied air (i.e., bottle watch), and hot work (i.e., spark watch). Important: This course is NOT for Confined Space Attendants (i.e., hole watch) 	\$50.00	1.5 hrs
Working at Heights (valid – 3 yrs)	HGT-WRKHT . This program is designed and delivered by the IEC in accordance with the MOL Working at Heights Training Program Standard. It ensures that workers exposed to the hazards of falling from heights have adequate knowledge about the hazards, personal fall protection equipment, and general safety practices needed to work safely at heights.	\$145.00	8 hrs
Working at Heights Refresher (valid – 3 yrs)	 HGT-WAHRE. This training reinforces key learning outcomes for workers who are exposed to the danger of falling from heights on construction projects and will update participants on any legislative, regulatory, or equipment changes. A practical demonstration of core competencies must be completed within one year onsite.	\$200.00	4 – 6 hrs
Practical Forklift (valid – 3 yrs)	FLT-FRKLTP . Onsite verification review of operator competencies established in FLT-FRKLT.	\$70.00	Review
Online Overhead Crane, Hoist and Rigging (valid – 3 yrs)	MCH-OCHRT . This course is for participants expected to work with or near overhead cranes. It provides a basic understanding of the hazards and controls used to manage risks associated with bridge, full gantry, and jib (overhead) cranes. This course is based on OHSA, Industrial Regulation 851, and identified CSA Standards.	\$100.00	3 hrs
Practical Overhead Crane (valid – 3 yrs)	MCH-OCHRP . Onsite verification review of operator competencies established in MCH-OCHRT.	\$70.00	Review
Online Transportation of Dangerous Goods (valid – 3 yrs)	TRS-TDGTR . This course provides basic information that shippers, handlers, and carriers need for road transport of dangerous goods. It aligns directly with identified regulation. Employers must provide additional job specific training for safe shipping and handling of dangerous goods.
