SAFETY ATTENDANT AWARENESS TRAINING: MOBILE EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIED AIR, AND HOT WORK

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Safety Attendant Awareness Training for Mobile Equipment, Supplied Air, and Hot Work is an awareness-level training program designed to be supplemented by site-specific information and training defined by the employer. The goal of this program is to provide participants with the general knowledge necessary to work safely as a safety attendant for mobile equipment, supplied air, or hot work.

Participants will learn about the duties of Safety Attendants for Mobile Equipment, Supplied Air, or Hot Work. They will also identify the methods of communication and the tools used to complete the job safely.

This course was designed for the Member companies of the IEC by a Subject Matter Expert Team that consisted of representation from Industry, Contractors and the Building Trades.

- Duties of a Mobile Equipment Safety Attendant, Supplied Air Safety Attendant, and Hot Work Safety Attendant
- Method of communication used by Mobile Equipment Safety Attendants and equipment operators
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) requirements

- Tools used to monitor supplied air operations
